

# Bandon Township Meeting Minutes

January 6, 2026

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 4:01 pm by Chairman Todd Sather at the town hall followed by the flag pledge.

Attendance: Todd Sather, Tom Gruendemann, Thomas Weikle and Paul Simonsen.

Absent: Joshua Buysse

Minutes of the previous meeting were read, and on a motion by Gruendemann and 2<sup>nd</sup>, was approved as read.

There was no Old Business.

New Business:

It was brought to the attention of the board that a local company may be getting into the road grading business. After discussion, the board expressed satisfaction with continuing with the county to do its grading. Bridge replacement work for the coming year was also discussed.

An \$11 million dollar cannabis community grant program available to the township was reviewed. Supervisors did not feel that the township has been disproportionately affected by cannabis prohibition over the years.

In preparation for the Annual Meeting, Gruendemann moved that the election judges and election board will be the town board. The motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> and passed. The meeting schedule and election hours for the day were reviewed and approved.

Monthly bills were presented for review. It was moved by Gruendemann and 2<sup>nd</sup> to pay the bills presented. The motion passed.

Treasurer Weikle reported a checkbook balance of \$128,570.12 with checks # 3211-3215.

The Annual Audit was conducted by the supervisors comparing the Treasurers financial records with the bank register and Clerk's claim forms. After checking numerous transactions, the supervisors were satisfied that the townships financials were in order. The townships financial records were declared audited and approved and signed to that effect by the board.

The next meeting is scheduled for March 10 at 2:30 pm, prior to the Annual Meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:55 pm.
